"Hear God's voice to know God's will."

John 10:3 - 4 (KJV)

³ To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. ⁴ And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the <u>sheep follow him: for they know his voice</u>.

- Hear God's voice to know God's will.
- Know God's will to follow Him.
- God speaks to us in a still, small voice.
- Take heed to what you hear. Must be a doer of God's word and hear God's voice.
- Hear the Word! Practice the Word!
- God desires to have a relationship with us.
- To have a relationship with someone you must know the person.
- To be a follower of Christ, you must hear God's voice and recognize God's voice.

I John 4:1 (NLT)

- ⁴ Dear friends, do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit. You must <u>test them to see if the</u> spirit they have comes from God. For there are many false prophets in the world.
 - God's word instructs us to test every voice and spirit.
 - Go to people for confirmation not for discernment.

How to Test God's Voice:

- 1. Agrees with God's Word
 - What you are hearing will be revealed through God's word.

I John 5:7 (KJV)

⁷ For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

2. Brings you closer to God

- Wisdom and success comes from hearing and doing God's word.
- Know God's voice when it is pure and peaceable.
- Know it comes from God when it moves you closer to God.
- Encourages spiritual growth.

James 3:17 - 18 (KJV)

⁷But the <u>wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. ⁸ And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.</u>

3. Agrees with nature of God

- God convicts not condemns!
- God corrects not attacks!
- God's voice is never discouraging, condemning, judgmental or demeaning.
- Voice of the Holy Spirit is never condemning.

Psalm 100:5 (TLB)

⁵ For the <u>Lord is always good</u>. He is <u>always loving and kind, and his faithfulness goes on and each succeeding generation</u>. <u>on to</u>

Romans 8:1 – 2 (KJV)

¹There is therefore now <u>no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus</u>, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. ² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8: 1 – 2 (MSG)

¹⁻² With the arrival of Jesus, the Messiah, that fateful dilemma is resolved. Those who enter into Christ's being-here-for-us no longer have to live under a continuous, low-lying black cloud. A new power is in operation. The Spirit of life in Christ, like a strong wind, has magnificently cleared the air, freeing you from a fated lifetime of brutal tyranny at the hands of sin and death.

Revelation 3:19 (AMP)

¹⁹ Those whom I [dearly and tenderly] love, I rebuke and discipline [showing them their faults and instructing them]; so be enthusiastic and repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, your sinful behavior—seek God's will].

- Nature of God is to hold us accountable.
- God is correcting and convicting you to help you grow and go to a new level.
- God corrects you to build you, not break you.
- God will bring the best out of you.
