² Do you see what this means—all these pioneers who blazed the way, all these veterans cheering us on? It means we'd better get on with it. Strip down, start running—and never quit! No extra spiritual fat, no parasitic sins. Keep your eyes on *Jesus*, who both began and finished this race we're in. Study how he did it. Because he never lost sight of where he was headed—that exhilarating finish in and with God—he could put up with anything along the way: Cross, shame, whatever. And now he's there, in the place of honor, right alongside God. When you find yourselves flagging in your faith, go over that story again, item by item, that long litany of hostility he plowed through. That will shoot adrenaline into your souls!

- Study how Jesus endured the cross.
- Take life lessons from Jesus and apply them to your life.
- Know what is on the other side.
- Jesus wants to take you from glory to glory.
- · Focus on the finish and finish strong!

5 Benefits of What Jesus Did on the Cross:

- 1. Fulfilled what God had promised.
- 2. Satisfied God's Justice.
- 3. Cancelled our debt of sin.
- 4. Defeated the fear of death.
- 5. Destroyed Satan's power.

⁴⁴ And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.

⁴⁵ And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst.

⁴⁶ And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

- When you are in the valley, remember what God told you on the mountain top.
- In the dark season, remember what God told you in the light.
