“The faithfulness of God is connected to your hope, joy, faith and trust in God.”

Deuteronomy 7:9 (KJV)

⁹ Know therefore that the LORD thy God, He is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations.

- Faithfulness is God’s attribute.
- Have faith in God’s faithfulness.
- Don’t build your life on circumstances, build your life on the Rock.
- People disappoint, but God won’t.
- God will carry out what He says that He will do.
- What God promises, He will perform.

Psalms 89:33 - 34 (KJV)

³³ Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail.

³⁴ My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.

- God is a promise keeper.
- God will not break His promises.
- When God gives a promise, He will not take it back.
- God can and will fulfill your dreams.
- God will not let go of the dream.
- God makes it beautiful in every season.
- Great is God’s faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:17-22 (KJV)

¹⁷ And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgot prosperity.

¹⁸ And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD:

¹⁹ Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall.

²⁰ My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.

²¹ This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.

²² It is of the LORD’s mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

- Focus and feed on the faithfulness of God.

- God is faithful, loving, forgiving, restoring and strengthening.
- For every new season, you should change the way you think and get a new mindset.
