Psalm 103:1 - 3 (KJV)

¹Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. ² Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: ³ Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

- Covenant is an agreement.
- See God as your Savior, protector, provider, and healer.
- Faith won't work until you are fully persuaded.
- Faith begins where the will of God is known.
- Build your life on the word of God which is the will of God.

Luke 5:12-13 (KJV)

And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on his face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

And he put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

- The covenant of health and healing.
- God's will is for us to live in health and wealth.
- · Humility always comes before healing.
- Honor comes before humility.
- Your faith will never work if there is an "if."
- Be fully persuaded and know that it is God's will for your healing.
- Jesus come to heal and restore!

How To Be Established In God's Will & Healing:

- 1. Find God's will in God's word.
 - Experience, see, taste, and attest to the will of God.

Romans 12:2 (KJV)

² And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2. Study the life of Christ.

Hebrews 1:3 (KJV)

³ Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.

John 14:9 (KJV)

⁹ Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

3. God didn't create bad things.

Genesis 1:31 (KJV)

³¹ And God saw everything that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

4. God's forgiveness of sin.

Romans 5:12 (KJV)

¹² Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.

- 5. Obey God's word.
 - Be in faith for God.
 - Jesus can take bitterness in your life and turns it into sweet.
 - Hear, say, and do the word of God and His promises.
 - Give God a legal right to heal you.

Exodus 15:23-26 (KJV)

²³ And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were bitter: therefore, the name of it was called Marah. ²⁴ And the people murmured against Moses, saying, what shall we drink? ²⁵ And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them, ²⁶ And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

- Worship the Lord and His blessings will come and He will take away sickness and disease.
- Praise releases God's blessings.
