"Walking out God's calling is living out your purpose."

5 Attributes When You Walk in God's Will and in Your Purpose:

1. Accepted
2. Needed
3. Wanted
4. Fulfilled
5. Happy

Romans 8:28 (NIV)

²⁸ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who ^[a] have been called according to his purpose.

- Happiness, fulfillment, and satisfaction are the results of walking in God's will and living out your purpose.

Keys to God's Will and Calling:

1. Everyone has a call on your life from God.
2. God called you before He created you.
 - God made you on purpose for a purpose.
3. Your mistakes will never cancel out God's call on your life.
 - God's call is irrevocable.

Matthew 22:37-38 (KJV)

³⁷ Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. ³⁸ This is the first and great commandment.

Called to....

1. Love God.
 - God is first in your life.
 - Love God and make Him the center of His life.
 - Loving God you will want to obey Him.

2. Know God.
 - Go to God first before making decisions.
3. Pursue God's calling.
 - Walk in God's calling and fulfill His purpose for your life.
 - God's peace and presence are released.

Philippians 4:7 (MSG)

⁶⁻⁷ Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.

- If God is at the center of your life – less worry.

4. Called to live a productive life.
 - Called to bear fruit.
 - Fruit that remains is leaving a legacy.
 - My lifestyle should bring glory to God.

John 15:5 (NIV)

⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

John 15:16 (NIV)

¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.
