"A Kingdom Builder and their inheritance."

Matthew 6:31 (AMP)

- ³¹ Therefore <u>do not worry *or* be anxious</u> (perpetually uneasy, distracted), saying, 'What are we going to eat?' or 'What are we going to drink?' or 'What are we going to wear?
- ³² For the [pagan] Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; [but do not worry,] for your heavenly Father knows that you need them.
 - Put your faith in God, not in circumstances.
 - Let God be in control!
 - God's Word does not work when you worry.
 - Worry chokes the Word!
 - You cannot receive from God when you live double-minded.
 - Cast all your cares on the Lord and start worshipping Him, then clarity comes.

Matthew 5:5 - 8 (AMP)

- ⁵ "Blessed [inwardly peaceful, spiritually secure, worthy of respect] are the ^[a]gentle [the kind-hearted, the sweet-spirited, the self-controlled], for they will inherit the earth.
- ⁶ "Blessed [joyful, nourished by God's goodness] are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness [those who actively seek right standing with God], for they will be [completely] satisfied.
- ⁷ "Blessed [content, sheltered by God's promises] are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.
- ⁸ "Blessed [anticipating God's presence, spiritually mature] are the pure in heart [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], for they will see God.
 - Am I seeking God's Kingdom or mine?
 - Seek God's Kingdom and His righteousness first by <u>advancing God's Kingdom</u>.
 - Advance the Kingdom through good works.
 - Our works in God's Kingdom determine our inheritance.
 - Works have everything to do with rewards.
 - Works are connected to your inheritance.

Revelation 2:26 (AMP)

²⁶ And he who overcomes [the world through believing that Jesus is the Son of God] and he who keeps My deeds [doing things that please Me] until the [very] end, TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY and POWER OVER THE NATIONS.

Revelation 22:12 (AMP)

¹² "Behold, I (Jesus) am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, ^[a]to give to each one ^[b]according to the merit of his deeds (earthly works, faithfulness).

Revelation 1:5 – 6, 10 (AMP)

⁵ And from Jesus Christ, the ^[a]faithful *and* trustworthy Witness, the ^[b]Firstborn of the dead, and the Ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who [always] loves us and who [has once for all] ^[c]freed us [or washed us] from our sins by His own blood (His sacrificial death)— ⁶ and formed us into a kingdom [as His subjects], ^[d]priests to His God and Father—to Him be the glory *and* the power *and* the majesty and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

¹⁰ I was in the ^[a]Spirit [in special communication with the Holy Spirit and empowered to receive and record the revelation from Jesus Christ] on the ^[b]Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like the *sound* of a trumpet.

Revelation 17:14 (AMP)

¹⁴ They will wage war against the Lamb (Christ), and the Lamb will triumph *and* conquer them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *and* on His side are the called and chosen (elect) and faithful."
