# "Hearing always precedes healing."

## **Questions To Ask About Healing:**

- 1. Does God heal?
- 2. Will God heal?
- 3. How does God heal?
- See God as a Healer!
- Hearing always precedes healing.
- Increase your hearing of God's Word.
- Get in God's presence to hear the word of God.
- God's word brings faith.
- Put your faith on and mix it with God's word to receive.
- Faith comes when the will of God is known.
- As long as you are "questioning" you cannot "receive" God's will for your life.

## Luke 5:1 - 13 (AMP)

<sup>1</sup>Now it happened that while Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret (Sea of Galilee), with the people crowding all around Him and listening to the word of God; <sup>2</sup> that He saw two boats lying at the edge of the lake, but the fishermen had gotten out of them and were washing their nets. <sup>3</sup> He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little distance from the shore. And He sat down and began teaching the crowds from the boat. <sup>4</sup>When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon [Peter], "Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch [of fish]." <sup>5</sup> Simon replied, "Master, we worked hard all night [to the point of exhaustion] and caught nothing [in our nets], but at your word I will [do as you say and] lower the nets [again]." 6 When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their nets were [at the point of] breaking; 7 so they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats [with fish], so that they began to sink. 8 But when Simon Peter saw this, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Go away from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" 9 For he and all his companions were completely astounded at the catch of fish which they had taken; <sup>10</sup> and so were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon [Peter]. Jesus said to Simon, "Have no fear; from now on you will be catching men!" 11 After they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him [becoming His disciples, believing and trusting in Him and following His example]. <sup>12</sup> While Jesus was in one of the cities, there came a man covered with [an advanced case of] leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and begged Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean and well." 13 And Jesus reached out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately the leprosy left him.

#### Romans 12:1 - 2 (AMP)

<sup>1</sup>Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies [dedicating all of yourselves, set apart] as a living sacrifice, holy and well-pleasing to God, *which is* your rational (logical, intelligent) act of worship.

<sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but <u>be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes]</u>, so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His plan and purpose for you].

- Know and prove the will of God by hearing God's word.
- Healing begins with renewing your mind.
- Formula for healing is: "Renewing Knowing Believing Receiving."
