THE GREAT COMMISSION (Acts 1:6–11, Matthew 28)

Week 1

Brite Idea: The Holy Spirit empowers believers.

He Question: Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is God and has all of the power and authority of God. He is the Helper Jesus promised.

We Question: How does the Holy Spirit help us?

When we trust in Jesus as Savior, the Holy Spirit helps us follow God, remember His Word, and spread His Gospel throughout the world.

PETER PREACHES AT PENTECOST (Acts 2:1–41)

Week 2

Brite Idea: The Holy Spirit convicts us.

He Question: Why does the Holy Spirit convict us?

Because God loves us so much, the Holy Spirit helps us realize we sinned so we can repent and have a right relationship with Him.

We Question: What can we do when we feel convicted about sin?

We can confess our sin to God, seek His forgiveness, and seek to live His way.

TABITHA IS RAISED FROM THE DEAD (Acts 9:36–43)

Week 3

Brite Idea: The Holy Spirit works in us and through us.

He Question: Where is the Holy Spirit?

The Spirit has always lived in community with God and Jesus. Because He is God, He is omnipresent and at the same time He dwells inside of every believer.

We Question: How does God work through us?

The Holy Spirit equips us with special gifts and talents so we can respond to opportunities to show His love to others.

PETER AND CORNELIUS (Acts 10)

Week 4

Brite Idea: The Holy Spirit leads us.

He Question: What does the Holy Spirit know?

Because He is God, the Holy Spirit is omniscient. He knows everything including the deep thoughts of God.

We Question: How can we know what God wants us to do?

There are many ways the Holy Spirit guides us today. He guides us to truth as we read God's Word and pray, helping us understand who God is, how much He loves us, and what He wants us to do.
