Monthly Memory Verse

GOD'S WISDOM (Proverbs 2-3)

Week 1

Brite Idea: God is the source of all wisdom.

He Question: Where does wisdom come from?

God is the true source of all wisdom. Since He is omniscient, He always knows what is best and right.

• We Question: Why is it important for us to seek God's wisdom?

... Our knowledge and understanding are limited. God's is not. His way is always the right way, and He wants to give us His wisdom.

WISDOM WITH FRIENDS (P)

(Proverbs 13:20, 17:17, 27:17)

Week 2

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom for friendships.

He Question: What kind of friend is Jesus?

 Jesus is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. He loves at all times. He is the perfect friend and is an example to us of how to be a friend. • We Question: What kind of friend does God want us to be?

We must be wise in choosing our friendships. God wants us to help our friends be more like Him by choosing kindness, loyalty and honesty.

WISDOM WITH WORDS

(Proverbs 18:21, 10:19, 15:1, 12:18)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom in how we speak.

He Question: Does God care how I speak to others?

God wants me to honor Him and others with my words. Our words can be used to bring Him glory rather than hurt others.

We Question: Why do our words matter?

Our words are powerful. Our words can hurt others and ruin our own lives.
God calls us to be wise in how we speak.

WISDOM IN HOW WE USE MONEY (Proverbs 3:9-10, 30:7-9)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom in how we use money.

He Question: Does God care about money?

Everything belongs to God. He gives us money and resources to manage and He wants us to use them wisely.

We Question: How does God want us to view money?
