

CREATE

an activity that allows preschoolers to review the Bible story, bottom line, or memory verse by creating a craft to take home

1. VERSE CELEBRATION

WHAT YOU NEED: "Celebration" Activity Page, cardstock, party stickers, glue sticks, and confetti paper

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Celebration" on cardstock. One per child.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Help the child place the stickers and glue the confetti paper onto the Activity Page around the memory verse.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Say the memory verse with the children.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Our memory verse tells us that nothing can separate us from God love!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "We are special to Him just like in our Bible story, today! Let's celebrate like the woman did. Let's decorate our page with party stickers and confetti. Let's celebrate!" (*Do activity*.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Nice work! God loves us, and we are very special to Him. That is something to celebrate! Let's say our memory verse. Nothing at all can ever separate us from God's love, Romans 8:39. Perfect! Who loves you? God loves me!"

5. LOTS OF LOVE

WHAT YOU NEED: "Gingerbread Person Outline" Activity Page, cardstock, crayons, and heart stickers

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Make a copy of "Gingerbread Person Outline" on cardstock for each child.

(Suggestion: Choose colors of cardstock that reflect diversity. Every child should see himself or herself.)

MEMORY VERSE

"Nothing at all can separate us from God's love."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to use crayons to make their "Gingerbread Person Outline" look like them. Give each child one heart sticker to go on their page. Send at least 10 heart stickers home with each child so they can use their "Gingerbread Person Outline" to play a game with their family.

KEY QUESTION

Who loves you?

WHAT YOU SAY:

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "God made you. That means God loves you, and you are very special to Him. There is no one else like you! Today YOU are going to make this (hold up an Activity Page) look like YOU!" (Go to each child and talk about their self-portrait and how special they are to God.)


AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Your pictures look amazing! Each one is special

because God made each of YOU special! And the heart that you put on your BOTTOM LINE picture is because God loves you. I am sending a lot of hearts home with you so you can play a game with your family. The goal is to get as many hearts as you God loves me. can on the picture of you, because God loves you, A LOT! One more time, who

loves you? God loves me!"
