ABOUT OUR PURPOSE

Swordsman's Club is the Bible memory program specifically developed for Kindergarten - 5th graders. During this three-year program, your child will learn many portions of Scripture that will help shape their faith and ultimately encourage them to surrender their lives to Christ.

We have selected key Bible passages that focus on God's love, salvation, prayer, obedience, and praise. It is our hope that you and your child can work together as a family to memorize Scripture. We pray that we will be able to build on the foundation you are laying at home.

As your child memorizes God's Word, he/she will be able to live out 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the Word of God." It is our earnest desire that you participate with us by encouraging your child to learn the Scriptures and that God may richly bless your family as you study together.

GETTING STARTED

SWORDSMAN'S CLUB WEEKLY VERSES

Verses are assigned weekly for the children and the parents to work on together. Children who recite weekly verses will earn \$20 Kids Cash. If parents recite the weekly verse, children will earn an additional \$10 Kids Cash.



HOW DO WE MEMORIZE THE ASSIGNED PASSAGES?

KEEP IT SHORT AND SWEET: REPEAT DAILY

- Watch the weekly videos that will be texted to you on Sundays
- Attach the habit of memorizing with something you already do every day - during breakfast, driving to school, right after dinner, or at bedtime.
- Repetition is key, and consistency helps it stick!

USE MUSIC AND SONGS

- Turn verses into simple tunes or hand motions.
- Search YouTube or Spotify for Scripture memory songs (e.g., Seeds Family Worship, Slugs & Bugs).

MAKE IT VISUAL

- Create verse posters, flashcards, or even coloring pages.
- Use dry-erase boards, sticky notes, or chalk on mirrors to keep it visible.

PLAY GAMES

- Try memory match, fill-in-the-blank, or "erase-a-word" games.
- Make a puzzle out of the verse and have your child piece it together.

SAY IT TOGETHER

- Memorize as a family to encourage teamwork and accountability.
- Use call-and-response or echo-style repetition to help younger kids.

EXPLAIN THE MEANING

- Take a moment to talk about what the verse means in kid-friendly terms.
- Ask how they might live it out at school or with friends.

CELEBRATE PROGRESS

- Reward milestones with praise, stickers, or a small treat.
- Consider a "verse wall" or "Scripture crown" they add to as they memorize more.

MODEL IT

- Let your child see you memorizing and living out scripture-it teaches more than words ever could.



SWORDSMAN CEREMONY

To honor and celebrate your child's dedication and effort in memorizing God's Word, we will hold a special recognition ceremony in the Main Sanctuary at the conclusion of the program. This ceremony is designed to highlight the spiritual growth, perseverance, and commitment your child has shown over the past several weeks.

Each child will be individually recognized for their achievements, and we will celebrate the different levels of scripture memorization with awards, gifts, and medals. It's a powerful opportunity not only for the children to be encouraged, but also for families and our church community to witness and affirm the impact of hiding God's Word in their hearts.

HERE ARE THE DIFFERENT LEVELS OF RECOGNITION YOUR CHILD MAY RECEIVE

RIBBON: Awarded to all participants who completed at least 4 weeks of scripture memorization.

RIBBON + GIFT FROM PASTOR:
Awarded to those who memorized all of the required scriptures.

RIBBON + GIFT + SILVER MEDAL:
Awarded to children who memorized all required scriptures plus 4 bonus passages.

RIBBON + GIFT + GOLD MEDAL:
Awarded to those who went above and beyond by memorizing all required scriptures plus 6 bonus passages.

THE ARMOR OF GOD | NLT

¹⁰A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. ¹²For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. ¹³Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. ¹⁴Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. ¹⁵For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. ¹⁶In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. ¹⁷Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion.
